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I walked North from Hickey. Standing under the tree, I was about 2/3 the distance toward Arlington Drive.

You can see the Monterey Cypress branches going into the ATT lines on the PGE pole.

Michael Richardson has maps from Caltrans, SMC Public Works Acting Director Ann Stillman too.

Ann helped a lot when she found better maps. I know Ann from Colma Creek meetings.

SSF City Manager Captain Mike Futrell requested contract surveyors to reestablish missing monuments.

These are shown on several maps.

Caltrans owns 8' east side of the highway, toward San Bruno Mountain. It is less clear on the west side of the highway.

Residents along Duval Drive own a long way down the slope toward the west side of the highway.

It took a few maps to determine this. It will take a survey to determine the rear corners of each home lot.

PGE needs to clear the trees west side of road bed.

Caltrans needs to clear trees east side of road bed.

Area needs a current survey.

Caltrans right of way needs to be well marked.

Caltrans SF Planning needs to design & implement a plan for ADA compliance.

Samtrans needs to relocate the Arlington Drive bus stop north of Arlington Drive.

This bus stop is very dangerous & not ADA compliant.

This road is not ADA compliant. A wheel chair passed us while Caltrans had

the lane closed.

This is too dangerous for walkers, bikers too. I have multiple disabilities. Some are orthopedic disabilities.

There are too many cooks in the kitchen on this 72+ year old problem. My family has been here since June 19, 1959. This road has not improved since 1959.

Several SSF PD Officers have driven this road to examine the dangers since June 2021.

There was an accident just south of this stretch at Hickey 2 weeks ago I was told.

We have new senior SSF PD officers. Sergeant Fahmida Murphy is Traffic Sergeant.

I have requested this be brought to the TAC committee late March.

Scott Campbell is our new SSF PD Chief.

Caltrans has a 1990 MOU with SSF to maintain El Camino Real from each end of the city along El Camino Real.

Paul Wilson sent this to me months ago.
