Who is there:

- How are they acting?
- Have you seen them before?

See something, say something

- If it doesn't feel right, it probably isn't

Use plain, direct language



Location of Incident

- Exact location: address, Bus #, Route #, Last Stop or Next Stop



Description of Person

- Do they have a weapon?
- Head to Toe
- Any physical descriptions
- Location



Additional Information

- Where did you board the bus?
- What bus stop are you getting off at?

Call **911**
IN AN EMERGENCY

Personal Safety: Behavior

Behavior: Body

- Head up
- Confident posture
- Steady pace
- Stay in Groups

Behavior: Eye Contact

- Brief
- Not challenging

Behavior: Voice

- Cause a scene if needed
