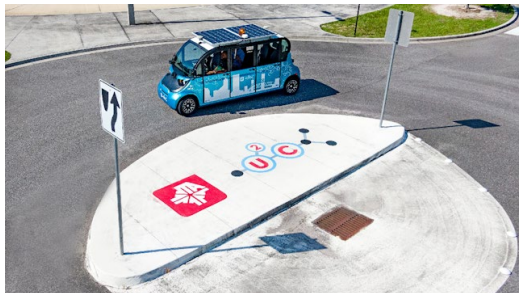

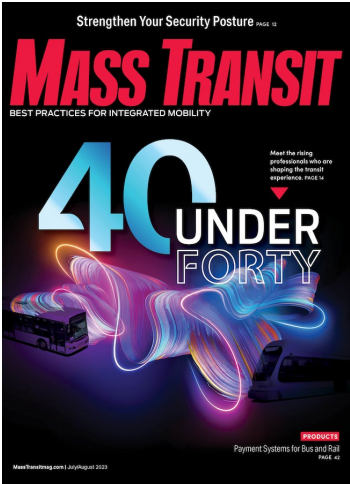

The connection will shorten the time and distance between the Bloor GO/UP Station and Dundas West TTC Station.

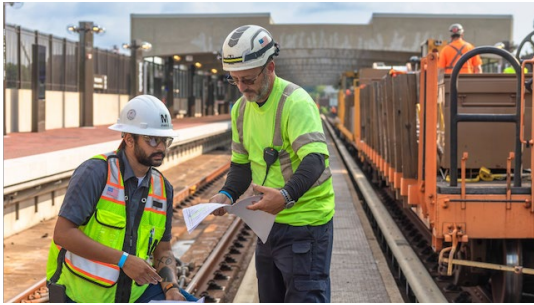


Second Caltrain Traction Power Substation energized with power

From Sept. 5 until Dec. 19, service will end approximately four hours early, allowing construction crews to continue work on the new Capstan Station.



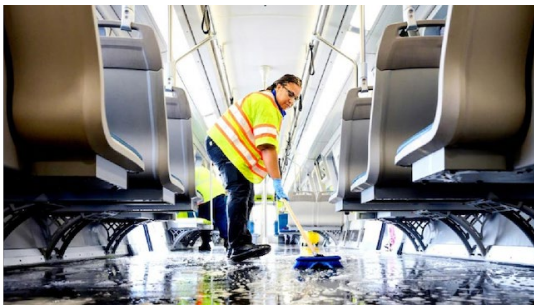

Four WMATA Green Line stations to reopen Sept. 2
