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To Board of Directors :

I have been taking FCX express bus from Foster City to San Francisco for work 5 days a week. First of all, thank you for adding more buses.

Starting August, SamTrans cancelled all the stops on Mission St. and reroute to have only one stop at SalesForce center which is on the east end of Market ST in San Francisco. For those who do not work around SalesForce (1st/Mission St), we were told there were options.

I tried walking 1.5-2 miles and missed the bus which made my commute 4 hours every day. I have been biking and Mission St has no bike lane and I had to struggle among buses and cars. I tried other streets which put a nail on my tire after 3 weeks of riding the bike and ran into a car which made an illegal right turn. One of the fellow riders got her wallet stolen on the muni on her way to SalesForce on September 19th. And another rider got into a very serious accident on her way to work from SalesForce on September 24 and have to have several surgeries. All of these transferring options prove to be very challenging and we are totally stressed out. So how do these meet your goal that you are trying to better the bus services, clean the air and making healthy communities while you are discouraging people from taking the bus and forcing them to drive?

This new route does not save people's time because FCX has to spend almost 10 minutes to circle inside the Salesforce and deal with mal-function signals and also the traffic jam around the center to get to highways.

We got more than 90% of the riders signatures to support FCX go down Mission St. to pick up passengers just like Bus 292. Please look at this from riders' view and consider the needs of the riders.
