Just so you know:

The requester must provide a Certificate of Insurance and must meet SamTrans' minimum insurance requirements in order to be issued a film permit. Film permits generally take 2 weeks to process. The requester must obtain a signed film permit to shoot on any bus or SamTrans location. The film permit must be present during the shoot and shown at the request of any SamTrans representative or peace officer. The permit is good only for the date(s) and time(s) indicated.

Fees: \$500-\$1,000 per permit (includes admin. fees and SamTrans location rep.)

Station usage fee @ \$150 per hour.

(2-hour minimum. All fees must be paid by or on the day of the shoot.)

Onboard bus: Other costs may apply depending on the complexity of the shoot.
