- Mechanism for vehicle sharing among cities, agencies and organizations in San Mateo County



- Need originally identified in the Senior Mobility County Senior Mobility Action Plan
 - Underutilized vehicle capacity
 - Unmet needs for group transportation

Demonstration Objectives



- Streamline access to vehicles at reasonable rates
- Facilitate partnerships to meet the transportation needs of seniors, people with disabilities, and others

Earn money: Lend buses and vans - others, besides other organizations on our website, have you don't need them.

Save money: Why buy new passenger vehicles when your organization can borrow them only when you need them?

Register now. It's easy. Register for Peninsula Fleet Share and gain access to a range of vehicle types rented by cities and organizations, available at reasonable rates. You can also advertise your own vehicles and receive as well as lease for drivers, so when you borrow from your fleet. We'll walk you through it and make sure you have all of the information you need to be ready to lend or borrow vehicles.


Registering is free if you respond now. A one-time administrative fee of \$75 is required to register, but if you register by June 28, 2012 we'll waive that fee.

Lend an unused vehicle or borrow a vehicle to temporarily increase capacity of an existing fleet, offer a special setting for seniors, provide job training transportation, or transport community members to park and recreation programs.


Cities, agencies, and other organizations in San Mateo County are trying to do more with fewer resources. Peninsula Fleet Share, a new program sponsored by the San Mateo County Transit District, provides a tool for sharing passenger vehicles among cities and organizations in San Mateo County.

- Realize cost savings and/or generate revenue that supports ongoing operation of transportation services
- Support mobility for the San Mateo County Area

How it works 

1. Organizations apply to be members
2. Sign an agreement with SamTrans
3. Receive a login to online database

For vehicle owners:

1. Enter information about vehicles into the database
2. Receive PFS vehicle magnet


For vehicle borrowers:

1. Search for vehicles to borrow
2. Contact vehicle owner
3. Report trips into database


